Current Situation

Currently, hospitals and temporary shelter applications are utilizing curtains, or other light-weight material, to separate patients, individuals, and animals.



To maintain sanitation, these curtains must be removed, washed, dried, and hanged.

The fabric's porous material also does not fully separate patients.



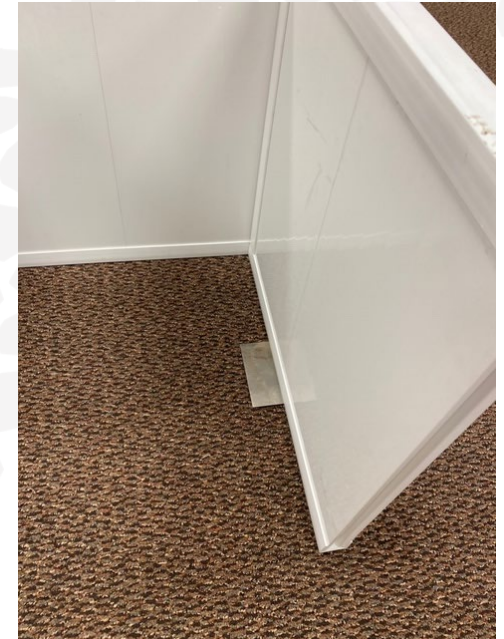
Solution: Agri-Clad

We believe that utilizing PVC wall panels during the COVID-19 crisis provides a safer, cleaner, and sturdier barrier. Given the panels' chemical resistance, they can be easily cleaned and sanitized.

Agri-Clad are our Heavy Duty interlocking PVC panels. They are portable and can be assembled in various ways to separate larger areas into smaller spaces. They are easy to assemble/disassemble by two people.

Agri-Clad: Benefits

- ✓ Made of non-porous PVC
- ✓ Coated to prevent yellowing and deterioration
- ✓ Chemically resistant
- ✓ Can be cleaned with soap and water or commercial sanitizer
- ✓ Can be easily assembled/disassembled





Agri-Clad: The Design

This is a full-size temporary wall unit measuring 6 feet x 6 feet x 6 feet with metal leg supports. The size of the space can be enlarged/reduced by increments of 1 foot.

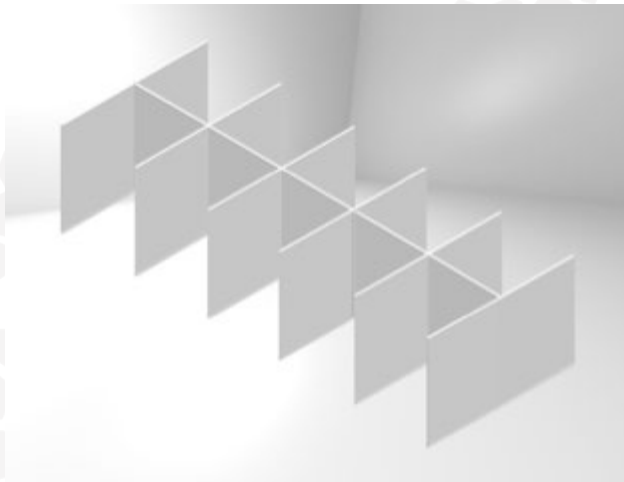




Agri-Clad: The Design

Here are examples of other possible configurations that can be made out of our Heavy Duty Planking panels.

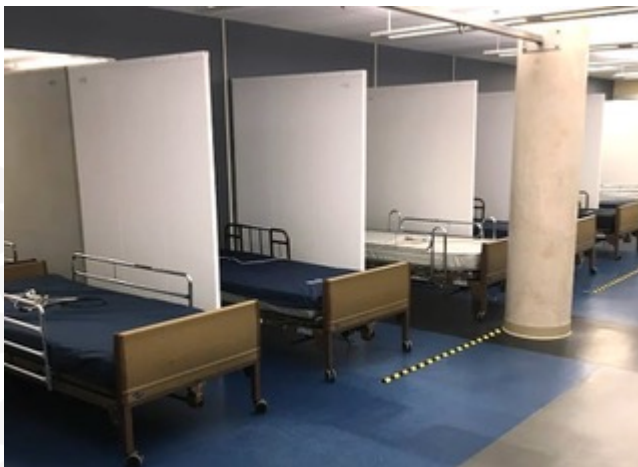
These panels are 12" wide x 1 3/8" thick.
